

CORRIGENDUM (EXTENSION OF DTAE)

INVITATION FOR SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Loan 3562-PAK: Punjab Intermediate Cities Improvement Investment Program (PICIIP)
Implementing Agency: District Governments of Sahiwal and Sialkot, Government of Punjab, Islamic Republic of Pakistan

1. The Government of Punjab has received a Loan from Asian Development Bank (ADB). Part of the financing will be used for **Urban Mobility Design and Supervision Consultant** financed by the Loan. The Local Government and Community Development (LG&CD) Department of Punjab is the executing agency of the project, and the city governments of Sahiwal and Sialkot (municipal corporations) are the implementing agencies. A Project Management Unit (PMU) has been established to support LG&CD Department, and two City Implementation Units (CIUs) have been established to support in Sahiwal and Sialkot. Under the guidance of the project steering committee, LG&CD Department is responsible for the overall execution of the project. The Sahiwal and Sialkot city governments are responsible for day to day project implementation. Consultants are being engaged to assist with project implementation, audit, monitoring, and institutional strengthening.

2. The project requires to recruit the **Urban Mobility Design and Supervision Consultant (the Consultant)** for the preparation of a Land-Use focused City Comprehensive Plan plan, Urban Mobility (transport) Plan and SWM Master Plan for the cities of Sahiwal and Sialkot; and for developing detailed engineering designs of a number of transport and SWM related civil works in Sahiwal and Sialkot cities. The consultant will support the PMU in procurement of goods and civil works (where needed) and will be solely responsible for providing construction supervision and quality control of these subprojects, involving supervision of contractors, control quality of construction and installation of equipment, implementation time, and cost, from inception up to completion in both Sahiwal and Sialkot.

3. The PMU, PICIIP hereby invites EOI from reputed international firms and/or in association with national firms. The consultants will be recruited using the **Full Technical Proposal procedure based on the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS)** method and in accordance with "ADB's Guidelines on the Use of Consultants by ADB and its Borrowers (2013, as amended from time to time)". Details of the assignment is given in table below:

The **Urban Mobility Design and Supervision Consultant (the Consultant)** will be headed by a **Project Leader/Manager (National)** and the team will be composed of national (key and non-key) and International (non-key) experts. The Interested firms should have demonstrated experience in relevant sectors and scope of work involved. The following short listing criteria has been formulated for the evaluation:-
